Background

Enables MDM2/MDM4 family protein binding activity; enzyme inhibitor activity; and protein N-terminus binding activity. Involved in several processes, including negative regulation of lymphocyte proliferation; positive regulation of apoptotic process; and regulation of transcription, DNA-templated. Acts upstream of or within several processes, including negative regulation of cellular protein metabolic process; negative regulation of mammary gland epithelial cell proliferation; and positive regulation of apoptotic process involved in mammary gland involution. Located in cytoplasm and granular component. Part of protein-containing complex. Is expressed in several structures, including bone marrow; central nervous system; dorsal root ganglion; eye; and testis. Human ortholog(s) of this gene implicated in several diseases, including breast cancer (multiple); carcinoma (multiple); hematologic cancer (multiple); melanoma (multiple); and nervous system cancer (multiple). Orthologous to human CDKN2A (cyclin dependent kinase inhibitor 2A).

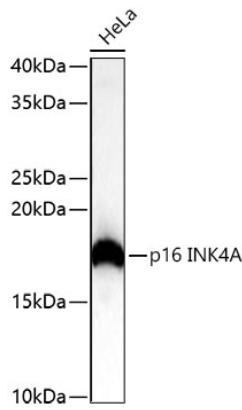

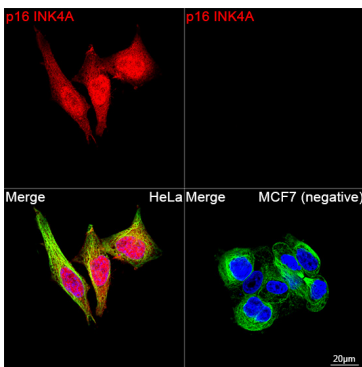

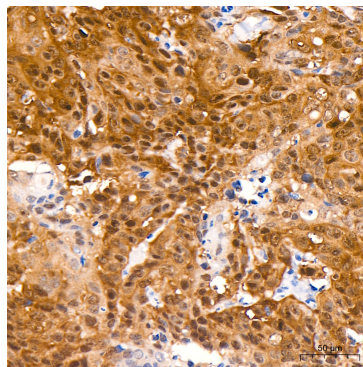

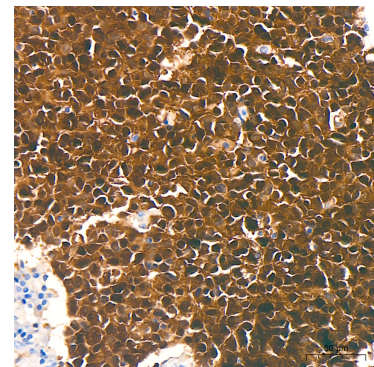

Secondary antibody: HRP-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (AS014) at 1:10000 dilution.
Lysates/proteins: 25 µg per lane.
Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST.
Detection: ECL Basic Kit (RM00020).
Exposure time: 90 s.



Confocal imaging of HeLa cells and MCF7 (negative) cells using p16 INK4A Rabbit pAb (A23882SP, dilution 1:200) followed by a further incubation with Cy3-conjugated Goat anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (AS007, dilution 1:500) (Red). The cells were counterstained with α-Tubulin Mouse mAb (AC012, dilution 1:400) followed by incubation with ABflo® 488-conjugated Goat Anti-Mouse IgG (H+L) Ab (AS076, dilution 1:500) (Green). DAPI was used for nuclear staining (Blue). Objective: 100x.
